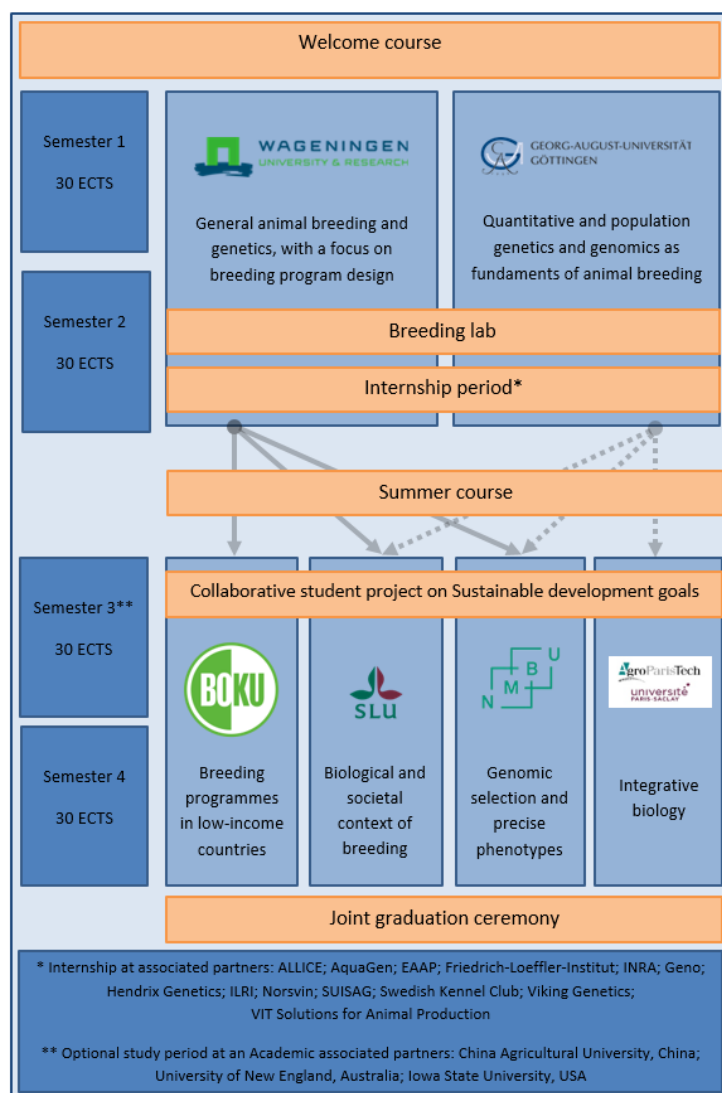
- Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree
